Our first reading from Isaiah sounds as if we were still in the Christmas season: “The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light.” But paired with today’s Gospel, which repeats that phrase, it makes a powerful prelude to the beginning of Jesus’ public ministry and the calling of the first apostles. Jesus’ response to John the Baptist’s arrest is to begin his announcement of the kingdom of heaven. How can today’s word of God help us to respond to adversity?

Schedule and registration for FTFCM for Spring 2017 now available!

The Formation Toward Christian Ministry (FTCM) program seeks to develop the basic academic, spiritual and critical reflection skills necessary for Catholic adults to fully answer their Baptismal call to service. FTFCM is open to all adults who seek greater understanding of their faith and is designed for those who are active in parish ministry or discerning their call to ministry.

FTFCM provides the theological content courses required for Diocesan certification as a catechist. In addition, FTFCM is a pre-requisite for Catechetical Leadership preparation, Youth Ministry Leadership training, and Diocesan certification as a liturgist. FTFCM is a 108-clock hour process delivered over the course of three semesters. Classes meet on weekday evenings or in all-day Saturday format, depending on parish request. Each class session includes prayer, content presentation and group dynamics. Each semester also includes participation in a Day of Reflection as a means to integrate content into daily living.

The 108 clock hours of FTFCM consists of 90 hours of courses and 18 hours of Days of Reflection. Course content includes the study of Scripture, Doctrinal Theology, Liturgical Theology, Moral Theology, and Church History. For more information contact our CCE Office, 281-499-4612 or online at

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

The month of January is traditionally dedicated to the Holy Name of Jesus. After the Blessed Virgin Mary conceived her Child by the Holy Spirit, the angel Gabriel appeared to St. Joseph and instructed him that the Child's name should be called Jesus, meaning "God Saves." For Catholics, Jesus' sacred name is the object of a special devotion symbolized by the monogram "IHS", (sometimes called a Christogram), which is the first three letters of the Greek spelling of Jesus' name. A bow of the head (signifies reverence) is made: at the name of Jesus, when the three Divine Persons (the Trinity) are named together, at the name of the Blessed Virgin Mary, and of the saint in whose honor Mass is being celebrated.

January is Sanctity of Life Month, and we unite our prayers for the unborn with all of you on the front lines. Prayer is our number one weapon against the enemy, but Scripture tells us being prepared to give an answer is just as important.

"But in your hearts, reverence Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to make a defense to anyone who calls you to account for the hope that is in you, but do it with gentleness and reverence." (1 Peter 3:15)

TRADICIONES DE NUESTRA FE

El mes de enero es tradicionalmente dedicado al Santo Nombre de Jesús. Después de la santísima Virgen María concibió a su hijo por el Espíritu Santo, el ángel Gabriel apareció a San José y le encargó que el nombre del niño debe ser llamado Jesús, que significa "Dios salva". Para los católicos, Jesús nombre sagrado es el objeto de una devoción especial, simbolizado por el monograma "IHS", (a veces denominado Christogram), que son las primeras tres letras griega de la ortografía del nombre de Jesús. Una inclinación de la cabeza (significa reverencia) está hecha: en el nombre de Jesús, cuando las tres Personas Divinas (La Trinidad) se nombran conjuntamente, en nombre de la santísima Virgen María y del santo en cuyo honor la Misa se celebra.
