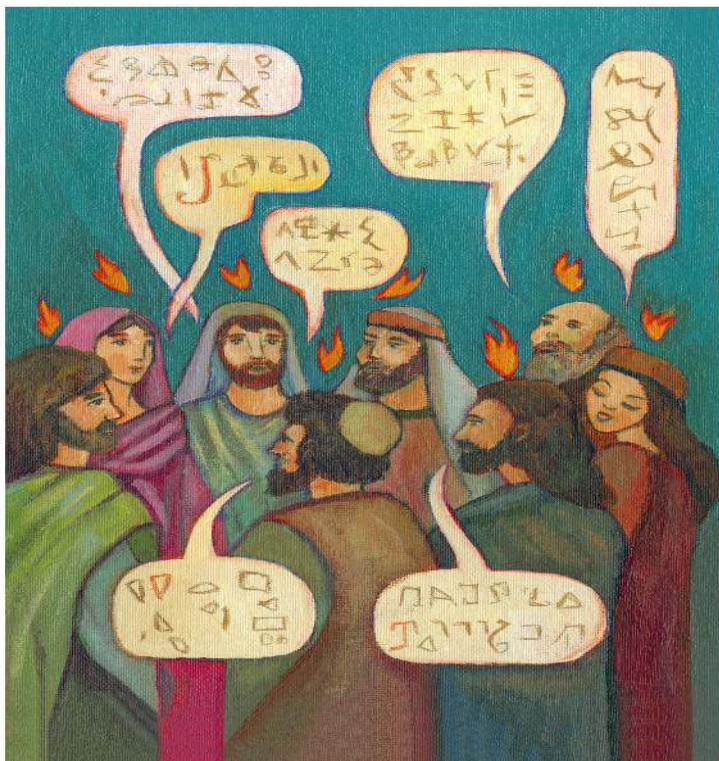

Excitement and Chaos

Today's Readings: Acts 2:1-11; Psalm 104:1-2, 24, 29-30, 31, 34; 1 Corinthians 12:3b-7, 12-13 or Galatians 5:16-25; John 20:19-23 or 15:26-27; 16:12-15. The scene we hear about in Acts 2 is filled with excitement and a bit of chaos. Imagine yourself gathered with the faithful disciples and suddenly you hear "a sound like the rush of a violent wind" and see tongues of fire appearing. What comes to your mind? The disciples were still processing the death and Resurrection of Christ and discerning their next move. Jesus promised them an Advocate that would send them to the ends of the earth. Jesus trained them to go out to tell of God's mercy and love, but fear and uncertainty locked them away.

During Lent, the Church invited us to turn away from sin, and during these fifty days of Easter, we celebrated the gift of God's redemption. Today, as we close our formal celebration of Easter, we reflect on the power of the Holy Spirit filling the hearts of disciples throughout the ages. At Baptism, we received the Holy Spirit, who sends us forth to share the Gospel. How have you been roused by the Holy Spirit to work within your community and to share the Good News? At dinner, discuss how you might use your gifts to help build up God's kingdom.

ALL ARE SENT

Fifty days after Easter Sunday we celebrate the fulfillment of all God's promises in the feast of Pentecost, a feast that has sometimes been called the birthday of the church. One last time we are reminded that we Christians have received the Holy Spirit, not for our own benefit, but to enable us to follow our Christian vocation.

The centerpiece of the scriptures for Pentecost is the account in Acts of the Apostles of the sending of the Holy Spirit to the disciples. The other readings for this Sunday help us to understand what it means to live out our Christian vocation. Paul's letter shows us the gifts and fruits that the Holy Spirit gives to us. John's Gospel reminds us that Jesus has sent all his disciples to share his forgiveness and peace, through the power of the Holy Spirit.

Is the Lord calling you to serve on the Parish Pastoral Council? The PPC is made up of a group of dedicated parishioners that are voted in through a spiritual discernment process. The mission of the Pastoral Council is to bring the people of the parish and our neighbors closer to God through Worship, Service, Education, and Community.

The members serve as the eyes and ears to our Pastor. They advise, suggest, or otherwise support the needs of our parishioners by reporting to the Pastor at Council meetings. Pastoral Council Members are friendly, visible and interested in making the parish alive in Christ. The Pastoral Council is the Pastor's Council, and all meetings are held in his presence on the 3rd Monday of each month from 7:30 pm to 9:00 pm in the Centennial Room. Membership is a three year commitment. The spiritual discernment process is facilitated by someone from the Archdiocese and includes a combination of prayer, scripture readings, questions and answers with all new nominees, as well as current PPC members, participating.

Nominations will be accepted from May 12 to May 26th. Any registered parishioner of Holy Family may nominate him/herself or someone else, with his/her permission, who would like to serve on the Pastoral Council. Below is the nomination form which can be dropped in the collection basket or the church office on or before May 26th.

We are looking to fill three positions in June. The requirements for Council Member Candidates are: That they be 18 years of age or older, a registered member of Holy Family Parish, in good standing with the church, attend the "Come and See" Information Session on June 9, and attend the Discernment Process on June 16th in the Centennial Room. Commissioning of new members will be on June 17th or June 24th. Please pray about this calling, and answer the question: "Is the Lord calling me to serve in this Ministry?"

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

The disciples gathered on the fiftieth day after the Resurrection were not keeping their first Pentecost. For them, Pentecost was the fiftieth day after Passover, a feast of the first fruits of the harvest. It was the second most important feast of the year. Today, Jews gather on the eve of the feast to study scripture and the law, and after the feast begins at sundown, spend the day in joyful social gatherings. The meaning of the celebration is the giving of the law on Mount Sinai, so for Christians the connection to the gifts of the Holy Spirit is obvious. In Sicily and in the Pantheon in Rome, today the descent of the Holy Spirit is enacted with a stunning ritual. Some churches there have an "eye" in the roof open to the sky, called an *oculus*. After the Gospel today, thousands of rose petals fall from the *oculus* onto the assembly. Churches and homes are decked in greenery and flowers to express the new life the Holy Spirit brings on this, the "birthday of the church." —Rev. James Field, Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.
