Dear Sisters and Brothers of Holy Family,

“Your light must shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your heavenly Father” (Mathew 5, 16), Jesus told us on the sermon on the mount. Lent is a time of grace and spiritual renewal in which we try to purify ourselves through our prayer, fasting and penance and let the light of Christ shine through us. So, we chose the theme ‘Let us shine the light of Christ’ for our Lenten season this year.

Let us make sure to make this Lent fruitful by spending more time in prayer, reflection, reconciliation, adoration, spiritual reading and fasting from those things that keep us from shining the light of Christ in our daily lives. It won’t happen if we don’t schedule it in our busy life commitments. Please make sure to actively participate in our special Lenten programs, especially our Lenten Retreat and reconciliation. Please mark your calendars for our Lenten Retreat with Fr. Bruce Nieli, a renowned preacher, April 3-5 (English Mission) and 6-9 (Spanish Mission). Our Lenten Penance service (confession) will be on March 29th. We have a wonderful opportunity to grow in our spiritual life by reflecting on the word of God in a special way through the ‘Best Lent Ever’ program. Please visit the website www.BestLentEver.com and sign up. It’s a free email program featuring internationally acclaimed preacher Mathew Kelley. From Ash Wednesday through Easter Sunday you will get short inspirational videos and personal reflections to grow spiritually during Lent.

Thank you so much for your great support for our Lenten Project last year. We raised \$37,058 for lighting our new and beautiful parking lot. Our Lenten project this year is to update and improve our church lighting by converting Halogen bulbs to LED lighting. You must have noticed more than dozen lights are out as of now in the church and the chapel. We have to replace all the lights in the church every two years and we need special equipment and man power which costs us over \$10,000 every two years. If we update to LED it needs to be replaced only every 10 to 12 years. We can also save on our power bill since LED lights consume minimal power. LED lights emit less heat so it helps us especially in the hot summer days. Our goal is \$40,000. So please get your Lenten family containers from the church or parish office and place your daily Lenten sacrifice in it, bring it every Sunday and empty it in the ‘church box’ in the sanctuary or in the Narthex. Our Lenten sacrifice will make a big difference in our beautifully remodeled church and also help us to save in our operating budget.

Let us renew our spiritual life and shine the light of Christ through in this season of grace by actively participating in our Lenten programs.

Ustedes habrán notado que más de doce lámparas están apagadas en el Templo y la Capilla y necesitan remplazarse. Este tipo de lámparas se tiene que remplazar cada dos años y se necesita equipo especial y mano de obra lo cual cuesta \$10,000. Al cambiar a lámparas tipo LED las cuales necesitan cambiarse cada 10 a 12 años. Podríamos ahorrarnos en la energía eléctrica mensual y emiten menos calor nos ayuda especialmente en el verano. Nuestra meta para proyecto es recaudar \$40,000. Así que por favor llévese su contenedor familiar que se encuentran en el vestíbulo y coloque sus monedas de cambio en este contenedor y tráigalo a la Misa y coloque sus monedas en el “cajón de la iglesia”. Nuestro sacrificio cuaresmal hará una gran diferencia en nuestro hermoso Templo y nos ayudará a ahorrar energía eléctrica lo cual se notará en el presupuesto operativo. Renovemos nuestra espiritualidad y brillemos con la luz de Cristo en esta temporada de gracia al activamente participar en nuestros programas de Cuaresma.

You may nominate yourself or someone else with their permission. Nomination forms will be in the bulletin in the next couple of weeks. **Nomination period will close on 3/17/17.**
