## May 28, 2017 Seventh Sunday of Easter

Dear Sisters and Brothers of Holy Family,

We have some good news! As of now we have raised \$40,050 for our Lenten project to replace the church and chapel lights with LED lights. Thank you so much for your great sacrifice and generosity. The LED lights and fixtures are on the way and we are working on a schedule for installation.

Thanks also for your generous and sacrificial support to our 'Growing Together in Christ' Campaign (Building fund) for the last three years. We have reduced our debt of our beautiful remodeled church and new Religious Education building from 2.7 Million to 1.8 Million. We have paid for our new parking lot about \$255,000. The balance due is only \$20,000. Let us thank God for blessing us to grow together in Christ through this Campaign and I thank in a special way Mr. Nilon Elliott and the Building Committee and all of you who helped in different ways achieving our goals.

Over the last couple of months, we have been meeting with the Archdiocese about our new campaign efforts, however, we have been asked to make some changes to include the Archdiocesan Campaign to raise funds for the Archdiocesan seminary, faith formation and schools. When our beloved Cardinal asks something, we know that it is very important and we need to support it for the future of the church. This will mean that we will have to delay the next campaign until October to give adequate time for planning with the Archdiocese and to organize a revised campaign.

With this however, we have an issue to be taken care of. Our mortgage needs to continue to be paid. This means that we need at least \$20,000 a month to meet our mortgage obligation from now until the end of the year to bridge the gap between the end of the current campaign and the beginning of funds from the next Campaign. I deeply appreciate how you have responded in the past and ask that you continue your support, particularly in achieving this monthly goal. Please make sure to continue your support for our building fund through your monthly or weekly donations, Electronic giving through Faith Direct, second collections, etc. You may use the special envelopes placed in the Church entrance tables.

As we celebrate the Feast of the Ascension of the Lord we are reminded about the Missionary mandate of Jesus. *"Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you, I am with you always until the end of the age."* (Mathew 28:19, 20). Through all our efforts of supporting the church and ministries of evangelization we are following this command of Jesus. Wishing you all the blessings of the Feast of the Ascension of the Lord! Fr. *Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos de la Sagrada Familia,*

*¡Tenemos buenas noticias! A partir de ahora hemos recaudado \$ 40,050 para nuestro proyecto de Cuaresma para reemplazar las luces de la iglesia y de la capilla con luces LED. Muchas gracias por su gran sacrificio y generosidad. Las luces LED y accesorios están en camino y estamos trabajando en su instalación.*

*Gracias también por su generoso apoyo y sacrificio a nuestra Campaña "Creciendo unidos en Cristo" (Fondo de construcción) durante los últimos tres años. Hemos reducido nuestra deuda de nuestra hermosa iglesia remodelada y el nuevo edificio de educación religiosa de \$2.7 millones a \$1.8 millones. Hemos pagado por nuestro nuevo estacionamiento alrededor de \$ 255,000. El saldo pendiente es de sólo \$ 20,000. Demos gracias a Dios por bendecirnos para crecer unidos en Cristo a través de esta campaña y agradezco de manera especial al Sr. Nilon Elliott, Paul Czervinske, al comité y a todos ustedes que ayudaron de diferentes maneras a lograr nuestras metas.*

*Durante los últimos meses, nos hemos reunido con la Arquidiócesis para hablar de nuestros nuevos esfuerzos de campaña, sin embargo, se nos ha pedido que hagamos algunos cambios para incluir la Campaña Arquidiocesana para recaudar fondos para el seminario arquidiocesano, la formación religiosa y las escuelas. Cuando nuestro querido Cardenal nos pide algo, sabemos que es de mucha importancia y necesitamos apoyarlo para el futuro de la iglesia. Esto significa que, tendremos que retrasar la próxima campaña hasta octubre para dar tiempo suficiente para la planificación con la arquidiócesis para organizar una campaña.*

*Con esto, sin embargo, tenemos un problema que debe ser cuidado. Nuestra hipoteca debe continuar pagándose. Esto significa que necesitamos al menos \$ 20,000 al mes para cumplir con nuestra obligación hipotecaria desde ahora hasta el final del año para cerrar la campaña actual y comenzar los fondos de la próxima campaña. Aprecio profundamente cómo han respondido en el pasado y les pido que continúen con su apoyo, en particular para lograr este objetivo mensual. **Pentecost Celebration at Holy Family**  
**“Come forth from all Nations”**  
**Sunday, June 4, 2017**

**The Second Reading for next Sunday, Pentecost, is 1 Corinthians 12:3b-7, 12-13.** *“As a body is one though it has many parts and all are parts of the body, so also is Christ. For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body; whether Jews or Greeks, slaves or free persons and we were all given to drink of one Spirit.”*

**The game of one-upmanship can cause trouble even in religious communities.** When St. Paul wrote this letter to the Corinthians, they were debating about whose spiritual gifts were better. Did those who speak in foreign tongues have a more valuable gift than those who could prophesy? The truth is revealed in this letter. All of the gifts of the Spirit are valuable. And they are one in the Body of Christ. Whatever our different gifts, there is one God who produces them and makes us one. As the Church was filled with the Holy Spirit at Pentecost we were each filled with the Spirit at our Baptism. **With your children this week brainstorm about the gifts and talents that each of you have.** How do you think the Holy Spirit wants these gifts to be used in the Body of Christ? List ways of using these gifts in the family, the parish, the world. Pray this prayer with your family this week: *“Lord, send us your Holy Spirit to help us walk in unity of faith and grow in the strength of His love to the full stature of Christ, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, forever and ever. Amen”*

### TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

If you could somehow transport a third-century Christian into your twenty-first-century Sunday Mass, once the initial shock wore off he or she would be more or less at home with the structure of the first part of the liturgy, the Word. The second part might be more difficult to comprehend. The stumbling block would be the book. We have a book, a missal that is set down on the altar with a very precisely prescribed set of words for the priest to say and the people to sing at the Eucharistic Prayer. In the early days of the church, there were no set “formulas” for this prayer. The ancients would have raised eyebrows at our “bookishness” since they preferred to let the prayers roll forth from a gifted leader of prayer. There was a basic shape to the prayer of thanksgiving, and almost general agreement that the words of Christ at the Last Supper ought to be included.

By the second century, Justin Martyr wrote that the presider “gives thanks at some length . . . and when he has finished the prayers and the thanksgiving, all the people present give their assent by saying ‘Amen.’” In the world before books, people could memorize long passages of prose and poetry, and so it is easy to see how particular phrases or expressions passed from church to church.
