## TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

The achievement of the late 1960s and early 1970s in enriching the "euchology" or "words of thanksgiving" available in the Church's prayer is important on many levels. Ecumenically, it means that the Latin Rite now reflects the wealth of the East in having more than one prayer available to the Church. Pastorally, it actually acknowledges the place of the assembly in prayer, which is particularly clear in the Masses with Children. In fact, the traditional prayers of the Eastern Church served as models for our new prayers.

In the East, what we call the Eucharistic Prayer is called the *anaphora*, and there are three main families of *anaphora*. Each family has a different "recipe" for arranging the usual parts of these prayers. All *anaphora* have "intercessions" included, but the Churches of Antioch place them toward the end of the prayer, Alexandria prefers them at the beginning before the "Holy, Holy," and Syria puts them at the very end. One branch of the Syrian family is unique in not mentioning the words of Jesus at the Last Supper. The Roman Canon we once prayed exclusively has some connection with the Alexandrian family, but once the signal for creativity was given, all the wealth of every prayer tradition was on the table, and our Sunday Mass has been greatly enriched.

## TESOROS DE NUESTRA TRADICIÓN

*El logro de finales de los sesenta y principios de los setenta en el enriquecimiento de la "euchología" o "palabras de agradecimiento" disponibles en la oración de la Iglesia es importante en muchos niveles. Ecuménicamente, significa que el rito latino refleja ahora la riqueza del Oriente al tener más de una oración a disposición de la Iglesia. Pastoralmente reconoce el lugar de la asamblea en la oración, lo que es particularmente claro en las Misas con los Niños. De hecho, las oraciones tradicionales de la Iglesia Oriental sirvieron como modelos para nuestras nuevas oraciones.*

*En el Este, lo que llamamos la Oración Eucarística se llama la anáfora, y hay tres familias principales de la anáfora. Cada familia tiene una "receta" diferente para arreglar las partes usuales de estas oraciones. Todas las anáforas tienen "intercesiones" incluidas, pero las Iglesias de Antioquía las colocan hacia el final de la oración, Alejandría las prefiere al principio antes del "Santo, Santo", y Siria las pone al final. Una rama de la familia siria es única en no mencionar las palabras de Jesús en la Última Cena. El canon romano que una vez oramos exclusivamente tiene alguna conexión con la familia alejandrina, pero una vez que se dio la señal de la creatividad, toda la riqueza de toda tradición de oración estaba sobre la mesa y nuestra misa dominical se ha enriquecido mucho.*
