TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

We've seen how the rescue of Eucharistic Prayer II from the mists of history changed the style of our prayer, introducing a sleek simplicity to the prayer said aloud by the priest. Remember, before the reform of our prayer in the late 1960s, the priest whispered the words of the Roman Canon, Eucharistic Prayer I. His voice was not amplified, his back was to the people, who could only tell what was going on by a shift in his posture as he bowed and genuflected and as bells were rung to indicate his progress through the prayer.

With the emergence of the new prayers, some feared that the old prayer would be lost forever if it weren't somehow changed. The reformers asked that it be streamlined a bit by omitting the repeated "Through Christ" at the end of various intercessions, and trimming the list of somewhat obscure saints. The new edition therefore brackets parts of the two lists of saints in the prayer, unfortunately dropping all the women from the second set. The decision was also made to keep the Lord's words at the consecration exactly the same in every Eucharistic Prayer, although there is precedent for more variety. On November 2, 1968, Pope Paul VI signed off on the plan of the new Mass, and by April 1969, the publication of the revised order of Mass was announced.

TESOROS DE NUESTRA TRADICIÓN

Hemos visto cómo el rescate de la Oración Eucarística II de las nieblas de la historia cambió el estilo de nuestra oración, introduciendo una sencillez de sencillez en la oración pronunciada en voz alta por el sacerdote. Recuerden, antes de la reforma de nuestra oración a finales de los años 60, el sacerdote susurró las palabras del Canon romano, Oración Eucarística I. Su voz no fue amplificada, su espalda fue para el pueblo, que sólo podía decir lo que estaba pasando por un se movió en su postura mientras se inclinaba y genuflectía y cuando sonaban las campanas para indicar su progreso a través de la oración.

Con la aparición de las nuevas oraciones, algunos temían que la vieja oración se perdería para siempre si no se cambiaba de algún modo. Los reformadores pidieron que se racionalizara un poco al omitir las repetidas "A través de Cristo" al final de varias intercesiones y recortar la lista de santos algo oscuros. La nueva edición, por lo tanto, entre paréntesis partes de las dos listas de los santos en la oración, por desgracia, dejar caer a todas las mujeres de la segunda serie. También se tomó la decisión de mantener las palabras del Señor en la consagración exactamente igual en cada Oración Eucarística, aunque hay precedentes para más variedad. El 2 de noviembre de 1968, el Papa Pablo VI firmó el plan de la nueva Misa, y en abril de 1969 se anunció la publicación del orden revisado de la Misa.
