## December 8, 2019 Second Sunday of Advent

Dear Sisters and Brothers of Holy Family,

Last Sunday we started our Advent journey of preparing for the most joyful feast of the year, Christmas. It is the season of waiting with joyful anticipation for the coming of the Lord. We pray in our mass after the Lord's Prayer "as we await the blessed hope and the coming of our Savior, Jesus Christ". Advent is the season we commemorate and celebrate the three comings of Christ and redemption. Christ's first coming which we celebrate in Christmas; His second coming in glory to judge the living and the dead and His third coming which is now, when Christ comes, first and foremost, in the sacraments.

"Prepare the way of the Lord" (Mathew 3, 3), we hear the words of St. John the Baptist, preparing the people for the first Christmas. "How do we prepare for the coming of the Lord? We need to prepare our hearts and minds to welcome Jesus anew in this Christmas time. We need to be prepared always for the second coming of the Lord. We have to be ready to welcome Jesus always as He comes through the sacraments.

"How do I prepare for my death?", someone asked St. Thomas Aquinas. "Walk always in the presence of Christ", he replied. Am I walking always in the presence of Christ? What is it that prevents me from walking in the presence of Christ? Let us find some quiet time and reflect on these questions during this Advent season. Schedule at least one hour every week for adoration and come before the Blessed Sacrament for reflection and meditation on Advent scriptures, which can be found in our 'my parish app' or website. So, offer a special gift to our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament.

Also, mark your calendar and come for our Advent Reconciliation on Tuesday, December 17th at 7.00 pm in the Church. Let us Prepare well and make a good confession so that we may welcome Jesus anew during this upcoming Christmas season.

**SAINT JUAN DIEGO (1474-1548) December 9**

How well Mary's own words describe Juan Diego: "God has cast down the mighty from their thrones and lifted up the lowly" (Luke 1:52). Through him, for the diverse peoples of the Americas, indigenous and immigrant, the Mother of God became known as their Mother, too. Cuauhtlatzin, his given name, means "One Who Speaks Like an Eagle," and Juan Diego faithfully delivered the Virgin's request that a church be built at Tepeyac where she had appeared to him. To the skeptical bishop's request for a sign, Our Lady showed Juan Diego roses blooming through stony ground, despite winter's cold. When he unfolded his tilma to present them to the bishop, imprinted there was Mary's image! Her blue sash and the flower over her womb were traditional Aztec symbols of pregnancy and new life. But her features were those of a mestiza, indicating mixed Aztec-European heritage. Thus to peoples too easily prone to a "clash of cultures," Our Lady of Guadalupe remains the enduring icon of unity-in-diversity, the fruit of our one baptism into Jesus, her Son. —Peter Scagnelli, Copyright © J. **SAN JUAN DIEGO (1474-1548), 9 de diciembre**

*Cuauhtlatotzin (el que habla como las águilas) fue un indígena mexicano de raza chichimeca nacido en Cuautitlán a quien Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe se le apareció por vez primera el 9 de diciembre de 1531 mientras iba a participar en la celebración eucarística que tenía lugar en Tlatelolco. La virgen le habló por su nombre indígena, en diminutivo, enalteciendo a Juan Diego y le pidió que fuera al palacio del arzobispo Fray Juan de Zumárraga y le pidiera que le edificara un templo, ahí en el lugar de las apariciones, en el Tepeyac. Juan Diego cumplió la misión, pero no le creyeron. Volvió a donde la Señora en dos ocasiones hasta que en la tercera, le pidió una prueba requerida por el arzobispo. Por mandato de la virgen corta rosas de castilla (de un lugar pedregoso y en temporada de invierno) y las lleva en su manto al arzobispo. Al descubrir el ayate ante Fray Juan, la Virgen de Guadalupe plasmó su imagen en la tilma de Juan Diego. Era el 12 de diciembre de 1531.*
